

Having received acclaim as a performer, teacher, and scholar, **Matthew Slotkin** is one of the most prominent young guitarists in the United States. Appearing in leading venues throughout North America and Europe, he has achieved success in solo performance, chamber music, and as a soloist with orchestra. He has appeared in concert venues throughout North America and Europe, including the Alexandria Guitar Festival, the UNC-Wilmington New Music Festival for Guitar and Saxophone, the Bowdoin Summer Music Festival, the Hartwick College Summer Music Festival, the Chautauqua Institution, and the DuMaurier Jazz Festival in Toronto, Ontario.

His first CD, *Twentieth Century Music for Guitar*, was released by Centaur Records in late 2003. American Record Guide praised Slotkin for his “musical sensitivity and technical control,” and for giving “strong readings of this appealing music.”

Matthew Slotkin directs the guitar programs at Mansfield University and Bloomsburg University. He has given master-classes at numerous institutions including the Oberlin Conservatory of Music, the Brooklyn College Conservatory of Music, the University of Saskatchewan, Syracuse University, the Alexandria Guitar Festival, the UNC-Greensboro New Music Festival for Guitar and Saxophone, and the Hartwick College Summer Music Festival. He has also taught guitar and chamber music at the Bowdoin Summer Music Festival, and classical and jazz guitar at Buffalo State College in Buffalo, NY, Alfred University in Alfred, NY, and in the Eastman School of Music’s Community Education Division. He received the Doctor of Musical Arts, Master of Music, and Bachelor of Music degrees from the Eastman School of Music, where he studied guitar with Nicholas Goluses and historical performance practice with Paul O’Dette.

Professor Murphy

Joseph Murphy has been the saxophone professor at Mansfield University of Pennsylvania since 1987. He has also been director of bands, department chair, and taught a variety of courses. He received the Bachelor of Music degree from Bowling Green State University (OH), and the Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees from Northwestern University. Dr. Murphy was the music director of Tiffin (OH) Calvert High School from 1983-85.

In 1985-86 he received a Fulbright Award for a year of study in Bordeaux, France where he received a Premier Prix.

In June 1996 Dr. Murphy performed a solo recital at Lincoln Center in New York City. He has performed in Europe, Taiwan, and Japan. He is a clinician for the Selmer Corporation and has recorded on the Erol (France), Opus One and Mark Record labels.

Dr. Murphy’s memberships include Music Educators National Conference, Music Teachers National Association, North American Saxophone Alliance, National Association of College Wind & Percussion Instructors, College Band Directors National Association, Phi Mu Alpha, and Kappa Kappa Psi. He has been involved in commissioning and premiering more than twenty new works for the saxophone, including pieces by Libby Larsen, Michael Colgrass, John Harbison, Bernard Rands, and Gunther Schuller.
